- Responsible for operating a bucket truck and truck and trailer in a safe and effective manner.
- Basic ability to understand documents, and identify and accurately troubleshoot problems.
- Requires the knowledge and skill in the safe use of ladders up to 14', scissor lifts to 20' and hand and power tools required in the related trade.
